### Vintage Race Boat Regatta

### September 15-16, 2023

The 2023 Vintage Race Boat Regatta will take place September 15-16 in beautiful, historic Wolfeboro Bay in Wolfeboro, New Hampshire. The event is **presented by the New Hampshire Boat Museum and is sanctioned by the Vintage and Historic Division of the American Power Boat Association (APBA).** This biennial event is now in its thirteenth year and is heavily attended by the public. It is also one of the premier events of the APBA Vintage Circuit.

Between 30-50 vintage race boats representing several classes from small outboards to Grand Prix hydroplanes will run heats in groups on a one-mile oval shaped course throughout the day Friday and Saturday. Other classes of boats include Jersey Skiffs and Gold Cup racing boats will also run. The sights and sounds of these great boats running are enjoyed by several thousand people at the Wolfeboro Public Docks.

Spectator participation is encouraged. There is no admission charge to view the heats on Friday and Saturday. The New Hampshire Boat Museum sells rides that can be taken between heats on various race boats with their drivers. Funds raised help support the educational programs and exhibits of the NHBM. Spectators are also welcome to come to all the evening events to meet the drivers as well as support the New Hampshire Boat Museum.

## **Spectator Opportunities**

#### THE HOT PITS

The Wolfeboro Town Docks is transformed into a staging and preparation area for the hydroplanes and other race boats that require "crane launching." This area is referred to as the "hot pits." In the hot pits, maintenance crews work on the boats, engines and drive trains, and the crane lifts the boats to and from the water.

Access to the hot pits is available to the general public when the operations are suspended for the lunch period, typically 11:00 am until noon. The owners and crew are available to answer questions, and share information about their boats and racing lifestyle.

#### **RACE BOAT RIDES**

Spectators can purchase a ride in some of the participating vintage race boats. The rides are generously donated to support the New Hampshire Boat Museum. Special heats have been scheduled for this unique opportunity.

#### **TOWN DOCKS**

The best viewing opportunities are from the numerous docks that flank the race exhibition area.
