Function of Position

The Dock Attendant oversees the *Miss Lauren* vintage boat ride kiosk located within North Water Marine in Paugus Bay. The Attendant checks passengers in and makes reservations for the *Miss Lauren*, as well as assists passengers with boarding and disembarking. The Attendant also assists the captain with docking procedures associated with departure and arrival of the *Miss Lauren*. The Attendant should be outgoing, friendly, and people-oriented. Must be available Memorial Day weekend in May through Columbus Day in October. Some weekend hours are required.

This position requires standing, sitting, walking on uneven surfaces, and climbing stairs. Must be able to lift at least 50 lbs from floor to waist. Assisting with tying up the boat requires being on a dock over water.
